



Stuttering and Linguistic Processing Lab

Monolingual English-speaking adults who do and do not stutter are needed to help in the investigation of cognitive and linguistic factors that contribute to stuttered speech.

- If you are at least 18 years of age
- If you are a monolingual English-speaker
- If you do not have a history of any speech/language/reading disorders or any cognitive, neurological, psychological diagnoses

You are invited to participate in an online paid research study focusing on the linguistic and cognitive factors that contribute to stuttered speech.

You will be asked to participate in a variety of speaking situations (e.g., picture description, conversation), complete testing of general cognitive ability, and participate in short experimental tasks (e.g., word/object/shape recognition etc.)

The entire study will take approximately 1 hour and you will receive a \$20 Tango card for your participation.
