

Are You a Person aged 18-50 who Stutters?

If you are a person who stutters, a native English speaker, and have no history of neurological disorders or hearing loss, you may be able to participate in a study that investigates differences in speech perception in those who stutter. You will undergo a hearing test, answer a questionnaire, and listen to words as a subtitled movie plays and an EEG records your brain activity. The time commitment is around 3 hours and volunteers will be compensated at \$15/hour. Research will take place at the University of Maryland, College Park, in the Hearing Brain Lab of LeFrak Hall.
