Intersectionality and the Experience of Stuttering for Latinos in the U.S.

Rationale/Aim

This is a research study about Latinos who stutter. The aim of the study is to develop a knowledge base on the background, stuttering and treatment history, and specific obstacles/barriers faced by Latinos who stutter living in the U.S. To participate, you must be 18 years or older. The study is composed of an interview that will be conducted virtually (Zoom) and an online survey to be completed after the interview. Participation in the interview and subsequent survey is voluntary. The virtual interview will take approximately 30 minutes to 1 hour. With your permission, the interview will be recorded and transcribed verbatim. The survey will take approximately 30 minutes to complete. It is meant to be an extension of the interview.
